The best case submissions will be selected for presentation on the day to compete competitively for generous prizes with a distinctive Galway theme (Machiavellian tactics will not be condoned by the organising committee!).

Cases should correspond to main themes of interest:

- Difficult management decisions
- Bio-psycho-social complications
- Challenging complications
- Rare infections
- Uncommon drug beneficial effects or side-effects
- Rare IBD manifestations
- Infrequent disease associations (neoplastic, infectious etc.)

Trainees and IBD nurses in particular are encouraged to submit cases of interest.
